Photo Editing Software – Using a Tripod

[Corel Photo Editing Beginning](#) (Monday, April 3 at 1:00 p.m. – \$25)

This is a beginning photo-editing class to learn the Corel PaintShop Pro software. This is a basic introduction to the key features. Learn about the tools, menus and all of the features. Corel rivals Photoshop in many ways, but easier to learn. If there is interest, there will be a more advanced class in the upcoming months.

[Topaz Plug-In](#) (Monday, April 10 at 10:00 a.m. – \$25)

The Topaz Lab plug-in has 13 different modules that are sold separately. We will concentrate on 5 of them: Topaz Adjust, Simplify, Impression, Glow, and Texture. You do not need to own them all as you can use the trial versions for the ones you do not own. These plug-ins can be stand alone or used with your favorite photo editing software.

[How to Use Your Tripod](#) (Tuesday, April 18 at 1:00 p.m. - \$25)

Although a tripod seems like a simple piece of equipment, there are a few things to keep in mind when you're setting it up to ensure you get the sharpest image possible. In this class, we'll go over those things as well as discussing types of tripods and some alternatives when you don't have yours.

[Photoshop Elements Advanced](#) (Thursday, April 20 at 10:00 a.m. - \$25)

The student will learn advanced techniques on how to edit, enhance, creatively combine, organize, and create various output products with photos using the powerful [Adobe Photoshop Elements](#) program. Handouts will be available for use at home.
